Long Pond Road Improvement Project Newsletter

June 5, 2014

!Long Pond Road to close to through traffic on June 23rd – Use Posted Detour!

This informational newsletter will provide periodic updates on the status of the project and communicate upcoming activities to effected properties and interested parties.

Project Description

This Monroe County Department of Transportation Project involves the reconstruction of Long Pond Road from approximately 500 feet north of Janes Road to the Lake Ontario State Parkway. The project includes reconstruction of the road with new storm sewers, some new water main, installation of a new concrete box culvert across the road, filling in of ditches, installation of curbing, reconstruction of the full depth pavement and some sidewalk work. The project will also reconstruct the Kuhn Road/Long Pond Road intersection and repave the pavement area over the Lake Ontario State Parkway.

Current Project Status

On June 23, 2014 at approximately 7:00 a.m. Long Pond Road will be closed to through traffic from Janes Road to Kuhn Road for approximately 1 week in order to install a new box culvert across the road. The Road will be open to local traffic from both directions up to the culvert, but the culvert will not be passable. The culvert is located just south of 418 Long Pond Road. The posted detour will be Kuhn Road to Flynn Road to Latta Road (See the attached map).

Following the one week road closure, Long Pond Road (from Janes Road to Kuhn Road) will be converted to a ONE WAY road open to northbound traffic only. Southbound traffic will be detoured (see the attached map). This one way detour is needed in order to safely reconstruct this section of roadway. It is anticipated that the one way detour will be in place for approximately 60 to 70 days in order to reconstruct the road. For the safety of other motorists and the workers, please obey the one way detour. It will be an inconvenience but the detour will allow us to expedite the road reconstruction. Thank you for your patience.

Overall Schedule

The schedule for the overall project is to have the project complete this fall.


