



Monroe County Influenza Surveillance October 1 – November 24, 2014


This is a preliminary report of Influenza cases. As of 11/24/2014, there were
 38 laboratory confirmed Influenza cases (35 Flu A, 3 Flu B and 0 Unknown) reported and 11 hospitalizations



Laboratory Surveillance: Positive influenza tests are reported on the NY State Health Information Network (HIN) by all diagnostic laboratories. The above figure shows the number and type of positive tests from Monroe County residents, and the percent of all tests performed that were positive for flu.



Emergency Room Surveillance: All 4 Monroe County Hospitals report to the HIN the total number of ED visits each day. Influenza-like illness (ILI) cases are those that have fever or fever and respiratory symptoms as chief complaint.



Long Term Care (LTCF) Surveillance: Beginning October 1, 2014, 32 Monroe County LTCFs are asked to voluntarily report ILI and flu activity each week.
