I recommend that Your Honorable Body adopt a home rule message in regard to the above bill.

This action will allow Jason Hendel to join the special retirement plan for sheriffs, undersheriffs, and deputy sheriffs under subdivision b of section 553 of the retirement and social security law.

This action will result in a one-time payment of approximately \$34,400 for past services costs and an increase of approximately \$9,690 in the annual contributions of Monroe County for the fiscal year ending March 31, 2016. In future years this cost will vary dependent upon billing rates and the salary of Deputy Sheriff Jason Hendel.

The specific legislative action required is to adopt a home rule message resolution for Senate Bill No. S.5564 entitled "AN ACT in relation to allowing Jason Hendel to join the special retirement plan for sheriffs, undersheriffs and deputy sheriffs."
