### Who is the MCDMH Response Team?

This team of volunteer mental health professionals responds to *local* disasters and provides crisis intervention to Monroe County residents.

### What is the eligibility criteria for MCDMH Health Responders?

- ◆ NYS licensed/credentialed, masters or doctorate prepared mental health/health professionals
- ◆ Training/experience in one of the following areas:
  - Human Services, Crisis Intervention, Disaster Training and Disaster Training Development/Implementation



### What are the expectations for volunteers?

- ◆ Volunteers will complete a **two day training, Disaster Mental Health: A Critical Response**. This training was developed by the NYS Office of Mental Health to ensure disaster preparedness amongst behavioral health providers across the state.
- ◆ Following completion of training, volunteers will have opportunity to participate in Monroe County exercises or drills and attend one educational meeting per year for team members.
