

Christmas Tree Recycling Programs 2018-2019



MONROE COUNTY residents may recycle their Christmas trees at the following locations. Residents save a valuable resource by having trees chipped into landscape mulch instead of disposing of them in local landfills.

Please remember to **remove all decorations, plastic bags, wires and nails** from trees to avoid damage to equipment. Where chipping is available, residents should check with their municipality for giveback programs - and **bring their own containers.**

Monroe County/Waste Management ecopark 10 Avion Drive Rochester, NY 14624	During operating hours, trees may be dropped off next to the compost give-back center (no woodchips). For details, go to www.monroecounty.gov/ecopark .
City of Rochester Department of Environmental Services – Operations and Parks Bureau	From Dec. 26 until Jan. 31, city residents may bring trees to the drop-off sites listed below or put them curbside on regular garbage collection day. Green Renewables, Inc.	After Christmas Day, trees may be dropped off at 225 Ballantyne Rd. Monday through Friday from 8 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Please stop at side door prior to drop off.
High Acres Recycling Center & Landfill Perinton	Perinton and Macedon residents may bring their trees free-of-charge to 425 Perinton Parkway from December 26 through January 31, Monday through Friday between 9 a.m. and 3 p.m. (closed from 11:30 a.m. – 12:30 p.m.) and Saturdays between 8 a.m. and 1 p.m. – non-residents \$1 fee.

Drop Off Location / Program Sponsor	Instructions
Town of Brighton	Town collects residents' trees curbside. Chips available until depleted.
Town of Chili	Town residents may drop off trees in the designated area at the former Highway Dept. (3235 Chili Ave.) throughout January. Curbside pick-up and woodchips are available.
Town of Clarkson	Drop trees off any day at the Highway Department, 3623 Lake Road, or Saturdays from 8 a.m. until 4 p.m. and Wednesdays from 2 p.m. until 7 p.m. at the designated area of the Transfer Station, 3078 Redman Road, north of 104.
Town of Gates	Normal weekly collection with brush pickup.
Town of Greece	Town residential curbside collection during January (weather permitting). Trees may also be dropped off any day at 635 Flynn Road (the Town transfer station) from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m.
Town of Hamlin	Residents may drop off trees through February 28 th at 91 Railroad Ave. (just past Highway garage) in brush pile.
Town of Henrietta	Residents may bring trees to the Tinker Nature Park, 1525 Calkins Road (behind the barn). They will be chipped on Jan. 12th and 13th from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. Donations for the Rush-Henrietta Food Cupboard will also be accepted during those times. Additionally, trees may also be left at the Nature Center throughout the month of January.
Town of Irondequoit – Helmer Nature Center, W. Irondequoit Schools	On January 12, residents may bring trees to the Helmer Nature Center, 154 Pinegrove Avenue, from 10 a.m. until 2 p.m.. NO TREES ACCEPTED AFTER 2 P.M.

Drop Off Location / Program Sponsor	Instructions
Town of Mendon	Residents may drop off trees anytime at the Highway Department, 101 Semmel Road. Please place on the brush pile.
Town of Ogden	Town residents may place trees at the curb any time after December 25, or drop in front of the Highway Garage, 2432 South Union Street.
Town of Parma	Town residents may drop off trees after December 25 at the designated area of the Parma Highway Garage at 51 Henry Street.
Town of Penfield	Trees may be brought anytime to the Penfield Highway Department office, 1607 Jackson Road, and placed under the "Christmas Tree Recycling" sign.
Town of Perinton	Residential curbside collection on normal collection day.
Town of Pittsford	Town will pick up trees left curbside in the beginning of January after contracted garbage companies have had a pick up opportunity.
Town of Riga	Town residents may drop off trees after December 25 at the Sprucewood Nature Center, located between North Main and Buffalo Streets behind the Churchville Elementary School.
Town of Rush	Residents may drop off trees after December 25 at the former Town Transfer Station on Stoney Brook Road.
Town of Sweden	Throughout the month of January, the Highway Department will pick up trees left curbside for residents.
Town of Webster	Residents may drop off trees from December 26 th through February 28 th at designated areas of the Town Garage, 1005 Picture Parkway.

Drop Off Location / Program Sponsor	Instructions
Town of Wheatland	Residents may drop off trees during the month of January at the Town Garage, 1822 Scottsville-Mumford Road.
Village of Brockport	Residential curbside collection from December 28 through February 28 th .
Village of Churchville	Residential curbside collection or residents may drop off trees after December 25 at the Sprucewood Nature Center, located between North Main and Buffalo Streets behind the Churchville Elementary School.
Village of East Rochester	Residential curbside collection.
Village of Fairport	Village regular curbside collection.
Village of Hilton	Village regular curbside collection. Normal brush collection on alternating weeks.
Village of Honeoye Falls	Village curbside collection throughout the month of January.
Village of Scottsville	Village curbside collection throughout the month of January.
Village of Spencerport	Village curbside collection throughout the months of January and February.
Village of Webster	Village curbside collection during the weeks of January 7 th and February 4 th . Place trees curbside on the Sunday prior to collection week. Chips available to residents in the spring.
