



## Hon. Anthony Daniele

Legislator Anthony Daniele represents the 10th Legislative District, which includes a majority of the Town of Pittsford, and a portion of the Village of East Rochester and the Town of Brighton. In November 2007, Legislator Daniele was elected to a four-year term and was re-elected in November 2011. In 2012, Anthony was chosen by his republican colleagues to serve as Majority Leader of the republican caucus. Anthony also serves on the Transportation, Human Services and Ways & Means Committees.

Beyond his duties as a Monroe County Legislator, Anthony is a member of the Friends of the Pittsford Library. He is also a founding board member of the Dining Alliance and serves as a Director of the Anthony Funeral Homes Board of Advisors.
