Employment Opportunities for Assistant District Attorneys

The Monroe County District Attorney's Office is one of the largest and busiest prosecutor's offices in New York State in terms of caseload. The team of Assistant District Attorneys prosecuted more than 34,000 cases last year while serving a population of 750,000 people in the Greater Rochester Area.

District Attorney Sandra Doorley leads the office of 130 employees, which includes 79 full-time Assistant District Attorneys. The office is a partner with Monroe County and the law enforcement agencies that work to protect the community. New Assistant District Attorneys can expect to handle their own caseload for both jury and bench trials.

Attorney Application Process

Applicants to the Monroe County District Attorney's Office should demonstrate a sound work ethic and a willingness to embrace the challenges of a dynamic trial practice. The Office only hires individuals who have passed the New York State Bar Examination and are admitted to practice law in the state.

Applicants must commit to a minimal three-year employment period and must reside in Monroe County during their employment.
