Tajh Anderson Arraigned for 2005 Murder of
15 Year Old Stacy Long

Rochester, NY- Today at 2pm, Tajh Anderson was arraigned before Judge Argento in Monroe County Court for the 2005 murder of Stacy Long. Anderson, who was 14 years old at the time of the murder, is accused of shooting Long in the park behind the Campbell Street Recreation Center on October 13th of that year. Long was 15 at the time of his death. Kyle R. Steinebach, a Major Felony prosecutor with the Monroe County District Attorney's Office, will prosecute Anderson on charges of Murder in the 2nd Degree.

“This arrest was the result of many years of work between the Rochester Police Department, the Monroe County Sheriff's Department, the US Secret Service, and those of us at the District Attorney's Office,” said Steinebach. “I want to thank all of our partners in law enforcement for their efforts in helping to keep our community safe and ensuring that Stacy Long and his family receive justice.”

Tajh Anderson was indicted for Long's murder by a Grand Jury on June 2nd of this year. He remains in Monroe County jail pending trial, where he is serving time on an unrelated charge.
