### **Brighton Attacker Pleads Guilty**

The masked man who entered a woman's home in Brighton and grabbed her out of the shower plead guilty in court today.

21-year old Christopher Bayer, also of Brighton, was charged with 1<sup>st</sup> degree Burglary for the January 11, 2011 attack.

In front of Judge Stephen Miller, Bayer pleaded guilty to Attempted Burglary in the 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree.

Assistant District Attorney Caroline Morrison says the plea was extended due to the fact that the victim was not hurt, Bayer has no criminal record, and the victim and her family requested it.

Both the victim and defendant's families know each other.

Bayer will be sentenced to 6 months in jail, five years Probation, and a "no-contact" order of protection.

His sentencing is set for March 17, 2011 at 9:30 am.
