The Lead Renovation, Repair and Painting rule (RRP) affects anyone who is paid to perform work that disturbs paint in housing and child-occupied facilities built before 1978. This includes residential rental property owners/managers, general contractors, maintenance personnel and trade contractors including: HVAC, painters, plumbers, carpenters, and electricians.

Training is open to the general public yet seating is limited. Pre-registration is required.
Persons referred by Monroe County have priority registration.
