

BLEACH AS A SANITIZER

Recommended amounts of "bleach" to reach 50 ppm (parts per million) necessary for utensil sanitizing

+

Gallon(s) of Water

Ounces of Bleach

1	1 Teaspoon
3	Approx. ½ oz.
	(1 Tablespoon)
5	Approx. ¾ oz.
10	Approx. 1½ oz.
20	Approx. 3 oz.

A sanitizing solution of water and household bleach <u>must be changed</u> on a regular basis (depending on use) to provide adequate sanitation.

It is recommended that a warm 75°F water temperature be maintained in the sanitizing compartment of the 3 bay sink and that utensils be immersed for <u>at least one minute</u> in that compartment.

Sanitizer required for storing wiping cloths

and wiping surfaces that can not be immersed in the sink should reach 100 ppm or double that of utensil sanitizer.

- 1 Gallon of water + 2 Teaspoons of bleach
- 3 Gallons of water + 1oz. (2 Tablespoons) of bleach
