COURSE DESCRIPTION

Topic 1: Introduction to Land Use Law

Topic 2: New York State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA)

An overview of the New York State Environmental Quality Review process, explaining the roles and responsibilities of boards and applicants and exploring the SEQRA process through case studies to gain insights into real-world applications of environmental review.
