Today the family of Brian Sullivan presented Sheriff Patrick O'Flynn with a check for \$1,600 to cover the cost of sending an investigator to the Responding to Missing and Unidentified Persons National Training Conference in Appleton, Wisconsin. Sheriff O'Flynn accepted the check on behalf of the Monroe County Sheriff's Foundation.

Sheriff's investigator Jeffrey Branagan will attend the conference later this month. All expenses are being paid for by this gift from the Sullivan family.

His vehicle, a 1995 red Pontiac Sunfire, license plate # DXU3048, was found nearby at the end of Lettington Avenue.
